I also understand that regardless of previous held positions, the City of Brooklyn is not obligated to appoint me to a volunteer position. If appointed, I understand that prior to the expiration of my term, I am subject to suspension and /or removal by the Recreation Department for violation of any youth organization's policies or principles. I also understand that I will not be accepted as a volunteer coach until my background check is cleared by the recreation administration.

As a coach, I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow coaches, players, officials, and parents at every game and practice by demonstrating good sportsmanship. I expect to give and receive fair treatment. I will treat coaches, players, officials, and fans with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or abilities and we expect to be treated accordingly. I deserve to coach in an environment that is safe, free of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco and expect adults and peers to refrain from usage at all recreation programs and events.
